



Tour-Diary INGRIMM Potsdam, Rosenheim, Regensburg

16/11/2007 Potsdam, Lindenpark

Well, today is the day we've been waiting so long, getting onto the stage again. Also it's the Release Date of our first Album. An important day in our bandhistory.

As usual it started quite inconsiderably: We met around 11 am at our rehearsal room, stuffed our backline and the instruments into two cars and got on our way to Potsdam. My place was at the backseat of Klaus's Car, which I shared with Bassdrum, Microstand, Footpedal and other small garbage. To complicate the whole situation, the carton with the t-shirts was right behind me, like a Damoklessword, so if there would be sharp stopp...., well you can imagine my head wasnt too pleased, but actually it happened only once. The mood was fine, the streets empty and the bright femal voice of our navigational device (we learned to hate it) showed us the way. So we lumbered through the snowy bavaria up north. Underway through the East of Germany we trespassed places like Juchhöh (meansYehey) or Caputh (means destroyed), which gave us a good laugh and some bavarian jodeling. Arriving at Potsdam, rain instead of snow. Anyway, its not an Open Air. At the Lindepark (the location of our gig) we tried to find the door like Spinal Tap, well actually even bettern then them. After we found the right hole in the wall, the boss of that place showed us the way to the backstageroom with a buffet waiting for us. Well the only thing that shocked us, was.... no beer!! Unbelievable, but luckily this was sorted out fast. Though we arrived too early and the Crew of the Apocalyptic Raiders was still setting up the stage. We wasted our time by eating sandwiches and watching the setting up of the stage. Actually the location is great. Well, stage is ready, soundcheck is made and so we were able to put our garbage onto the small leftovers on stage. Meantime the boys of Morbid Mind joined us and we joined helping setting up the backline. Having 11 channels for the instruments led to not enough microphones for the drums, but actually we didnt mind it. At 8pm we entered the stage and we used our exact 35 minutes to blow our sound into the people. The location was already quite full and the crowd was into it from the first song on. A great start of our INGRIMM Mini-tour with the friendly Potsdam people. Afterwards we watched the show of the Morbid Minds and the Apocalyptic Raiders, gave some autographs before we went to some of Klaus's friends to sleep there. Well that was the point, where we decided to leave the nice Potsdam area

17/11/07 Rosenheim, TANZT!-Festival

At the next day in the morning, we made a poll, who was killing most of the trees and the winner was ME!!!, Poor Klaus, he was lying next to me and he was only able to gather some sleep by stuffing some plugs into his ears.

After a relaxed breakfast, we started for Rosenheim, but first we tried to find a gasstation with Cargas. Well that was the time we starting swearing at the navigational device. Potsdam seemed to contain only place with on building. After trying three time we found out, that the



gasstation was gone, so we set for the next one. We were led into a living area with nice houses and a horrible and bumpy street. Officially we arrived our aim, but I only saw nice family buildings. That was the moment we decided to leave Potsdam and find our luck on the highway with Alex behind us. Well luckily we found a gasstation at the highway and we made our way to south a little faster then usual. We had a good ride and so we arrived at 6pm in Rosenheim. The location was a club with everything for the medieaval heat: Clothes, gems, Met and everything else. So time was short for us, so the stuff on stage, the previous drums kicked off (because of unbearable sound) and Klaus ´s Drumset up, quick Line-Check.. thats it! At 8pm De Profundis opened the set with bagpipes and drums. Everyone had fun and afterthem it was up to us. My first question to the people was „You like it loud?“ The answer was a loud yelling of „YES“ and so they got it. We started the gig with „Ihr sollt brennen“, „Rattenstadt“ and „Skudrinka“ until „Letzte Reise“. Klaus had give a spontaneous Drumsolo and we ended with the encore „Vagentenlied“. We didnt get mcuh from the Bands after us (Vroudendspil and Nachtgeschrei), because of interviews and autographs. After all that we sat quite relaxed at the bar and had enough drinks with the fans. So finally the Promoter provided us with a sleeping place with a refrigerator fulll of beer. What a grave mistake....

18/11/07 Regensburg, CD-Release-Party

Obviously the beer was good, cause of no complaints about headaches or anything else. Therefore we set for Regensburg and we had lots of time, so everyone could take some siesta. In the afternoon we got the „Geflickte Trommel“ to prepare our CD-Release party. Sharif, our cupbearer provided us with cooled drinks and so the setup went quite swift. Getting evening, the first guests strolled in and also our Labelboss. He was quite surprised that the location is small, but to play there has some tradition for us. The „Geflickte Trommel“ was one of our first gigs we ever played, there we presented our demo and therefore also our first CD. The location was quite full (including our Fanclub for the first time) and so we started the party really loud (as it should be). According to the shortage of place, we werent able to do our stagacting, but that didnt kept us from having fun. During the Songs we introduced the people connected to the band and the origin of the cd and made the walls shake. After all that the party went on until we left the „Geflickte Trommel“ at dawn.
